The Tier System allows us to continue to offer our same low fees for summer camp, while letting everyone know the true cost of camp. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tier 1 is our historically subsidized rate and does not reflect the true cost of operating summer camp programs. • Tier 2 is our partially subsidized fee for those who can pay a little more but still cannot afford the actual cost of camp. • Tier 3 more closely accounts for the true costs of camp including wear and tear of buildings and grounds. This program is voluntary and will in no way influence the experience children receive, yet it offers the opportunity for families to take an active role in supporting the true cost of their child's camp experience.

A non-refundable deposit of \$110 per camp is required to secure your camper's spot at Lambton Centre. The balance of camp fees are due on or before June 30, 2010. Cancellation Policy: If you cancel your campers attendance before June 30, 2010 you will receive a full refund minus the non-refundable deposit of \$110. If you choose to cancel your campers attendance after June 30, 2010, you need to give two weeks written notice and would receive back your camp fees minus the deposit amount of \$110 per camp. Cancellations within two weeks of a camp starting will receive no refund unless a medical note is provided. This policy is in place to help Lambton United Church Centre better manage it's staffing needs and camper numbers. Registrations received after June 30, 2010 need to be accompanied by full payment.
