15. **OPEN WESTERN PLEASURE STAKE**: All horse and rider combinations **MUST** have been entered and paid into the Open Western Pleasure (Class 1) to qualify. Only the top 6 placings from each division, paid up in advance in the Pleasure Stake, will be eligible for the Stake class.

**Total entry fees collected plus \$350.00 added by MWHS to create the Stake purse.**

**ENTRY FEE: \$15.00 must be paid by the entry date deadline or pay double the entry fee up to the day prior to the beginning of the Western Horse Show. No post entries will be accepted once the Western Horse Show begins.**

**PAY OUT: 30%, 25%, 20%, 12%, 8%, 5%**

16. **OPEN BARREL RACE STAKE**: All horse and rider combinations **MUST** have been entered & paid into the Open Barrel Race (Class 13) to qualify. Only the top 20 fastest times after **all divisions** have run, paid into the Barrel Stake in advance, will be eligible for the Stake Class.

**Total entry fees collected plus \$350.00 added by MWHS to create the Stake purse.**

**ENTRY FEE: \$15.00 must be paid by the entry date deadline or pay double the entry fee up to the day prior to the beginning of the Western Horse Show. No post entries will be accepted once the Western Horse Show begins.**

**\*\*\* RULES & REGULATIONS\*\*\***

ALL GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS OF MWHS WHICH ARE PERTINENT TO THE HORSE SHOW WILL APPLY

**\*\*\*\*\* THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY NO PONIES ALLOWED \*\*\*\*\***

- 1. ENTRY FEES:** ALL classes #1 to #13: **\$10.00** A **\$3.00** Administration fee per horse .  
.... ..Barrel Stake & Western Pleasure Stake: **\$15.00** Exhibition runs – **\$10.00** each run applies.  
... ..Purina Elimination Race: **\$15.00** (limited to 32 horses – two horses run at same time)
  - 2. ENTRY FORMS:** must be received **BY MAIL** between **July 5<sup>th</sup>** and by **NOON, July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2010**. **NO ENTRIES POST MARKED PRIOR TO JULY 5<sup>th</sup> WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Late or early entries, incomplete entries and entries unaccompanied by entry fees will **not** be accepted. **ALL CHEQUES and/or MONEY ORDERS** for stalls, entry fees and all other costs are to be made payable to: **MWHS or Mid-Western Ontario Horseman's Society.**
- EACH HORSE MUST BE ENTERED IN A MINIMUM OF TWO CLASSES.**
- 3. POST ENTRIES PAID IN CASH ONLY:** will be accepted (at the office provided for the Western Horse Show Only) up until 2 hours before the class is to be judged at **double the entry fee per class.** The Hitching Ring Supervisor will be advised of your number, horse and rider for admission to the ring. This does **not** include Stake classes – which must be paid into prior to the start of the Western Fair (Sept 4<sup>th</sup>).
  - 4. STALL FEES:** Horse Stall - **\$40.00** TACK STALLS: \$40.00 Horses will be given priority over tack stalls and tack stalls will be assigned as space allows. **NOTE:** Application of payment does not guarantee any exhibitor a stall. The final allotment of stalls will be made by the MWHS/Western Fair Show Committee. If stalls are not available, an appropriate refund will be made. **Due to the limited number of stalls available, the number of horses to each division will be prorated (limited) if necessary.** Shavings will be available at a cost of **\$5.25** each, however, you need to include **payment and pre order amount required on your entry form.**
  - 5. IN MAKING ENTRIES:** the name of animal, owner and exhibitor **MUST** be listed.
  - 6. SHOW PACKAGES:** may be picked up in the stabling area Thursday, Sept. 16, 2010 from 9:30 p.m.– to 11 p.m. or Friday, Sept. 17, 2010 7 a.m. at ringside.
  - 7. ADMISSION:** There will be two wristbands allotted per horse at a cost of **\$15.00** each to cover the entire Western Horse show weekend (added to entry form). **The 2010 admission per day per person will be charged at the gate if no wristband is shown. Please do not argue with the gate staff – they are only doing what they have been told by their employer.**

8. **EXHIBITORS:** must be prompt in bringing all entries into the show ring. The Ring Announcer will make early calls for each section allowing adequate time for the exhibitors to prepare their entries and proceed to Hitching Ring Area. Any exhibitors who are not ready at final call will forfeit their entry fee and the right to compete in that section. The Judge and Ring Steward are instructed to proceed with each section as soon as it is called from the Hitching Ring and their decision regarding lateness shall be final.
9. **HORSES:** are to be measured in the shoes in which they are to be exhibited and special care should be taken that their measurement is correct. To be eligible to compete in the show, horses for open and adult classes must be 14 hands and over; horses for Jr. A classes must be over 13 hands. \*\* Representative of the Horse Show Committee may request the measurement of any entry that in his opinion may not meet the height regulation where applicable.

10. **EACH SECTION:** of the Horse Show must have at least three (3) different entries (actually shown) or else the prize money may be cancelled. Exhibitors will be informed as soon as possible following the closing date for entries that a section has been cancelled due to insufficient entries. **Classes with six or less entries, 100% of entry fee will be jackpotted.**
11. **TIME OF ARRIVAL:** **THURSDAY, Sept. 17 9:30 p.m - Arrival time must be strictly adhered to or trailers will be turned away. No early admission to the grounds.**
12. **TIME OF RELEASE:** Horses may be released after the conclusion of the show on Friday if they are not competing on Saturday, however, once your horse leaves you cannot bring it back in.
13. **NOTE:** All horses and tack must be removed from the grounds, Saturday, September 18, 2010. **THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**
14. **A Jr. A RIDER:** is any rider 18 years & under as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year riding a horse.
15. **IN THE EVENT OF DEATH AND/OR INJURY OF A HORSE** after entry to which the horse is unable to compete, the owner(s) may substitute or receive a refund of entry fees only, at his/her/their discretion, provided that proper veterinary certificate is submitted and the MWHS Western Fair Show Committee is satisfied that the said death/illness/injury did actually occur. Proper notification must be received by MWHS Western Fair Show Committee by 12 noon on the day prior to the **opening** of the Western Fair (Thursday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2010) **EXHIBITORS MAY NOT SUBSTITUTE UNENTERED HORSE and/or RIDER WITHOUT THE EXPRESS PERMISSION / KNOWLEDGE AND APPROVAL OF THE HORSE SHOW COMMITTEE.**

**NOTE:** Mid Western Ontario Horseman's Society rules will apply, **with the exception of Reining which will run under N.R.H.A. approved pattern,** in all Western Sections. Exhibitors, Judges and Show Officials are responsible for having knowledge of the rules. \*\*Due to the size of the ring, exact distances (as specified in the MWHS Rule Book for certain entries) will be modified where necessary,
