Class # 16 ASB Show Pleasure- Open Qualifier:

To be shown at a flat walk, trot and canter. Judged 75% on manners, performance, presence and quality; 25% on total conformation.

Class # 25 ASB Show Pleasure- Open Stake:

Must have entered, shown and judged in class 16. To be shown at a flat walk, trot and canter. Judged 75% on manners, performance, presence and quality; 25% on total conformation.

Class # 4 ASB 3-Gaited- Open Qualifier:

To be shown at animated walk, part trot and canter. Judged on performance, presence, quality, manners 75% and conformation 25%.

Class # 26 ASB 3-Gaited- Open Stake:

Must have entered, shown and judged in class 4. To be shown at animated walk, part trot and canter. Judged on performance, presence, quality, manners 75% and conformation 25%.

Class # 9 ASB Park- Open Qualifier:

To be judged on 75% performance, manners, presence, quality and 25% conformation. To be shown at an animated walk (animated or flat), trot and canter. Horses are to stand quietly.

Class # 15 ASB Park- Open Stake: *\$500 ADDED PRIZE MONEY*****

Must have entered, shown and judged in class 9. To be judged on 75% performance, manners, presence, quality and 25% conformation. To be shown at an animated walk (animated or flat), trot and canter. Horses are to stand quietly.

Class # 2 ASB Country Pleasure- Open Qualifier:

To be shown at a flat walk, trot and extended trot and canter. Judged 75% on manners, performance presence and quality; 25% on total conformation.

Class # 19 ASB Country Pleasure- Open Stake:

Must have entered, shown and judged in class 19. To be shown at a flat walk, trot and extended trot and canter. Judged 75% on manners, performance presence and quality; 25% on total conformation.

Class # 5 ASB Western Country Pleasure- Open Qualifier:

Shown at a flat walk, jog-trot and lope on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint (ridden with one hand on reins). Judged 75% on manners, performance, presence and quality; 25% on conformation and neatness of attire.

Class # 23 ASB Western Country Pleasure- Open Stake:

Must have entered, shown and judged in class 5. Shown at a flat walk, jog-trot and lope on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint (ridden with one hand on reins). Judged 75% on manners, performance, presence and quality; 25% on conformation and neatness of attire.

Owners and riders/drivers/handlers must be in current good standing with OEF and EC with a current OEF membership and an EC Bronze Sport License (at the least). For any further rules, please refer to EC Breed Guidelines as well as your local Morgan federation body. All exhibitors must be active members of the OMHC.

Class # 3 Morgan Classic English Pleasure- Open:

Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings. To be shown at a walk, pleasure trot, road trot and canter. Horses must stand quietly and back readily. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride, with the emphasis on manners and gait 60%, type and conformation 40%.

Class # 20 Morgan Classic English Pleasure Stake- Open:

Must have entered, shown and judged in class 3. Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings. To be shown at a walk, pleasure trot, road trot and canter. Horses must stand quietly and back readily. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride, with the emphasis on manners and gait 50%, type and conformation 50%.

Class # 8 Morgan Hunter Pleasure- Open:

Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings. To be shown at a walk, trot, extended trot, canter and extended canter. To be judged on performance with emphasis on manners and gait 60% an type and conformation 40%. Horses not to be tested on obstacles.

Class # 18 Morgan Hunter Pleasure Stake- Open:

Horses must have been entered, shown and judged in class 8. Open to Stallions, mares and geldings. To be shown at a walk, trot, extended trot, canter and extended canter. To be judged on performance with emphasis on manners and gait 50% and type and conformation 50%. Horses not to be tested on obstacles. Horses may be stripped.

Class # 1 Morgan English Pleasure- Open:

Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings. To be shown at a walk, pleasure trot, road trot and canter. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride, with emphasis on manners and gait 60%, type and conformation 40%. Horses not to be tested on obstacles.

Class # 22 Morgan English Pleasure Stake- Open:

Horse must have entered, shown and judged in class 1. Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings. To be shown at a walk, pleasure trot, road trot and canter. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride, with emphasis on manners and gait 50%, type and conformation 50%. Horses not to be tested on obstacles. Horses may be stripped.

Class # 12 Morgan Road Hack- Open:

Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings. To be shown at a walk, trot, road trot, canter and hand gallop. At any time during the class the judge may ask horses to half and walk off on a loose rein. Classes may be split for the hand gallop portion at the judges' discretion, for safety reasons. Excessive speed at the hand gallop will be penalized. To be judged on performance, manners and suitability for road hack 60%, type and conformation 40%. Rider's attire should be suitable for the saddle being ridden.

Class # 6 Morgan Western Pleasure- Open:

Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings. To be shown at a walk, jog and lope with a light rein. Horses must back readily. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride, with emphasis on manners and gait 60%, type and conformation 40%. Horses not to be tested on obstacles.

Class # 24 Morgan Western Pleasure Stake- Open:

Horses must have been entered, shown and judged in class 6. Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings. To be shown at a walk, jog and lope with a light rein. Horses must back readily. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride, with emphasis on manners and gait 50%, type and conformation 50%. Horses not to be tested on obstacles. Horses may be stripped.

Class # 10 Morgan Classic Pleasure Driving- Open:

Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings. To be shown at a walk, pleasure trot and road trot. Horses may stand quietly and back readily. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure drive, with emphasis on manners and gait 60%, type and conformation 40%.

Class # 27 Morgan Classic Pleasure Driving Stake- Open:

Horses must have been entered, shown and judged in class 10. Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings. To be shown at a walk, pleasure trot and road trot. Horses may stand quietly and back readily. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure drive, with emphasis on manners and gait 60%, type and conformation 40%.

Class # 17 Morgan Pleasure Driving- Open:

Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings. To be shown to an appropriate two wheeled vehicle at a walk, pleasure trot, and road trot. One attendant without whip must head each horse. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure drive, with emphasis on manners and gait 60%, type and conformation 40%. Horses may be asked to back.

Class # 29 Morgan Pleasure Driving Stake- Open:

Horses must have been entered, shown and judged in class 17. Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings. To be shown to an appropriate two wheeled vehicle at a walk, pleasure trot, and road trot. One attendant without whip must head each horse. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure drive, with emphasis on manners and gait 60%, type and conformation 40%. Horses may be asked to back.

Class # 13 Open Jr.Exh. Walk Trot Pleasure:

Entries are to be judged at a walk and trot. Riders will be judged on 80% performance, manners and presence and 20% conformation. Riders entered in these divisions may not show in lead-line classes or in any class or division calling for a canter or lope.

Class # 29 Open Jr.Exh. Walk Trot Equitation:

Open to youth 12 and under, Saddleseat, Huntseat or Western. Riders entered in these divisions may not show in lead-line classes or in any class or division calling for a canter or lope. Riders are to be judged on correctness of form and their ability to handle their animal. Stallions are prohibited. Ages of juniors are as of January 1st 2010. Judged 100% on performance and turnout

Class # 7 Stick Horse:

Open to kids 10 and under. Exhibitors must provide their own stick horse, show attire is optional. Entries are judged at walk, trot and canter and may be asked to back. To be judged 100% on performance and turnout.

Class # 14 Open Leadline:

Open to kids 10 and under, to be led by one adult handler. Performance of the child and suitability of mount to be considered. Stallions are prohibited. Ages of juniors are as of January 1st 2011. To be judged 100% on performance and turnout.

Class # 11 Parade- Open:

Horses are to be shown with western-type, decorative silver saddle and bridle. Breast plates, tapedaros and serapes may be used as additional appointments. 75% performance, manners, quality and Open conformation; 25% appointments of horse and rider. Desired characteristics are action, collection and brilliance. Gaits: Animated walk, Parade Gait (5km/hr max speed)

Class # 28 Open Novice Horse:

Open to any novice horse of any breed. Horses to be shown at walk, trot, and canter, and are to be judged on manners, conformation, way of going, and suitability for their division.

ONTARIO PROVINCIAL SADDLESEAT EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIPS

Entry Fee: \$15 per class

Saddle Seat Equitation 13 and under
Saddle Seat Equitation 14-17
Saddle Seat Equitation 18 and older

"These championship classes may only be entered by competitors who have qualified in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Ontario Provincial SS Equitation Championships, available on line at www.horse.on.ca or through the OEF office. Competitors are to be judged as a group at the walk, trot ,and canter both ways of the ring and they are required to individually execute the mandatory workout consisting of a figure eight at the canter, trot back to the judge, stop and back. Judging is based 50% on rail work, 50% on individual workout. Further testing of any contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. Please refer to EC Rules Section F Chapter 21 Saddle Seat Equitation."

Class # 30 Ontario Saddleseat Equitation Championship 13 and under:

Entries will be judged both ways of the ring at a walk, pleasure trot and canter. To be judged 100% on a rider's seat, hands, general management and control of the horse. Riders will perform an individual pattern as described in the EC saddleseat equitation rules. Open to all riders 13 years of age or under as of January 1st 2011 who have qualified for the championship.

Class # 31 Ontario Saddleseat Equitation Championship Adult:

Entries will be judged both ways of the ring at a walk, pleasure trot and canter. To be judged 100% on a rider's seat, hands, general management and control of the horse. Riders will perform an individual pattern as described in the EC saddleseat equitation rules. Open to all riders 18 years of age as of January 1st 2011 who have qualified for the championship. All adult riders must be amateurs and hold amateur status with EC.

Class # 32 Ontario Saddleseat Equitation Championship 14-17:

Entries will be judged both ways of the ring at a walk, pleasure trot and canter. To be judged 100% on a rider's seat, hands, general management and control of the horse. Riders will perform an individual pattern as described in the EC saddleseat equitation rules. The judge may ask for additional tests as listed in the saddleseat equitation rules. Open to all riders 14 years of age under 17 years of age as of January 1st 2011 who have qualified for the championship.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SECTION 1- MEMBERSHIPS

1. Any rider entering any class or division at this horse show and any person or group listed as the owner(s) on the entry form of any horse or pony entered in any class or division of this show, **MUST** be current members in good standing of the Ontario Equestrian Federation (OEF) and Equine Canada (EC) and must supply original or photocopy of their 2011 OEF membership card and 2011 EC Bronze license before they will be issued a number.

SECTION 2- ADMINISTRATION

1. Entries must be submitted via e-mail or mail before the closing date to avoid late fees. Entries must only be delivered to the show secretary (as mentioned above) by the previously mentioned methods. Entries submitted any other way or to any other person are not guaranteed to be received.
2. **REFUNDS:** Administration and stall fees are not refundable. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Class/Division fees will be refunded if cancellation is made in writing and delivered to the show office 48 hours prior to the start of the horse show with the required medical documentation. Once a horse has entered the show grounds, there

will be no refund unless authorized by the show secretary and manager. All unpaid scratch fees will be considered an outstanding account until paid in full and will be sent to the appropriate federation body.

3. PAYMENT: Stonecroft accepts the following methods of payment: cheque or cash. Payment is due in full before the closing date outlined in this prize list. No numbers will be issued to any horse or rider for whom an entry form has not been fully completed.

CHEQUES SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO: "STONECROFT EQUESTRIAN"

4. All NO SHOW entries will be charged full entry costs and an additional \$50.00 "no show fee". All accounts must be settled prior to the next show, otherwise entries will be denied. Please note any outstanding accounts at year-end will not be eligible to receive year-end awards.
5. A \$50.00 charge will be added to all accounts paid with cheques that are returned from the bank for any reason.
6. **Show management reserves the right to change or amend show scheduling at any time. It is the competitor's responsibility to check for times throughout the competition.**
7. Cancellations MUST be given to the show secretary by e-mail or direct phone contact. If cancellations are not given to the show secretary, the entry is considered a "no show" entry and must pay the applicable fees.

SECTION 3- GENERAL

8. Current Equine Canada rules will govern all sanctioned classes. Non-sanctioned classes will be ruled governed by the breed classes. In the case of open classes, follow the rules listed in the prizelist.
9. Dogs **are** allowed.
10. Food - Stonecroft will be hosting a BBQ around 5:00pm for all Exhibitors. A wine&cheese party will follow the evening provincial championship classes.
11. Lunging - Lunging will be permitted in the outdoor sand ring at anytime during competition.
12. P.A System – PA calls are considered a courtesy. Exhibitors are responsible for having their horses at the gate at the prescribed time.
13. Conduct- Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to Judges, Officials or Show staff on the part of the owner, trainer, rider or any other attendant, shall be grounds to disqualify the horse, and all entry fees and other charges and prize money won shall be forfeited. The Show Committee also bears the responsibility to aid the judge in avoiding contact with the exhibitors or their agents before and during the show. Horses shall not be punished unnecessarily or severely. No excessive whipping will be tolerated. Horses must be treated with respect at all times.
14. Tack Holds - Classes will run with a 2 minute gate as per EC rules. Only when a horse or rider/driver has back to back classes will a 3 minute tack hold be granted if requested before the commencement of the session.
15. Admission to Arena - No person will be permitted to enter the arena except class participants, judges, and their assistants, show photographers and show management personnel. Attendants will not be permitted in arena until summoned by order of the judge.

16. Approved headgear - Stonecroft strongly recommends that all competitors wear helmets during warm-up, especially junior exhibitors. When competing in the ring, show attire is required.
17. Management reserves the right to limit or close the entries of any class or division in an effort to adhere to the timetable. Please visit www.stonecroftequestrian.com for any notices regarding the prize list or changes to the timetable.

SECTION 4- RESPONSIBILITY

18. Stonecroft Equestrian and/or the owners of the show facility will not be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or in any way damaged. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person or any animal, or damage to any property while on the show grounds by any horse(s) owned by him/her, and shall indemnify the Management against all legally established claims or damages of any kind or nature that may grow out of any injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her.

They must never be subjected to mistreatment. Ensuring that the owner, trainer, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose. Providing for the continuous well being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure. Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare. Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices. Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions. Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses. The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.
